

A brief interactive Q&A session followed where students and faculty clarified their doubts and shared their own observations from clinical postings.



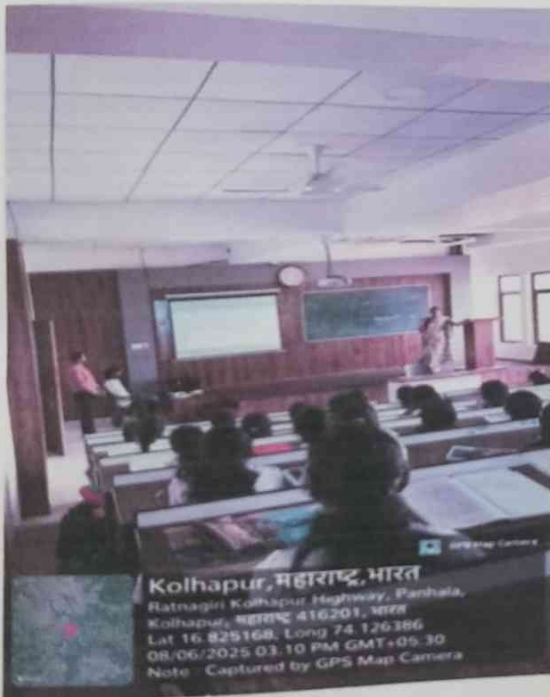
Conclusion:
