No. 8318 of 2018-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to your application vide dated **27.08.2018** forwarded by GOI vide letter No. **L.14012/12/2018-EP (1) dated 16.01.2019** on the subject cited above and to say that the physical and other infrastructure facilities available at proposed Ayurved College namely **Dr. Deepak Patil Ayurvedic Medical College & Research Centre AIP Borpadale, Tai. Panhala, Distt. Kolhapur-416213, Maharashtra** was visited on **21.02.2019** by the visitation team of the Central Council of Indian Medicine.

- In view of the letter of the M/O AYUSH vide ref. No.11011/03/2011 EP(H) Part dated 01.09.2017 wherein mentioned as, "the Council shall inspect college and issue Letter of Intent (LOI) at their level, if the college is found eligible. The Council shall again inspect/verify the compliance of the conditions of LOI and send the recommendation of either Denial/for issuing Letter of Permission (LOP) as the case may be, only once by 31st March for approval of the Ministry".
- 2. The visitation report and all other related papers were placed before the Executive Committee of the Council in its meeting held on 30.03.2019.
- 3. EC on careful consideration of the Scheme in terms of the regulation 6 and subregulation (3) of regulation 9 of regulations namely "the Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2003 read with Amendment Regulations of 2013, and provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made there under, has decided to approve the scheme.
- 4. The decision of the Executive Committee has been approved by the General Body in its meeting held on 31.03.2019.
- 5. In view of above LOI is issued to start New Ayurveda College in the name of Dr. Deepak Patil Ayurvedic Medical College & Research Centre AIP Borpadale, Tai. Panhala, Distt. Kolhapur-416213, Maharashtra with 60 seats in UG(BAMS) course (subject to fulfillment of requirement of library books before LOP) from the academic session 2019-20, under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 subject to the condition that following conditions shall be fulfilled before the inspection of the CCIM for issuance of Letter of permission (LOP) for the academic session 2019-20, failing which the recommendation for issuing Letter of Permission (LOP) shall not be sent to the M/O AYUSH, Govt. of India and Letter of Intent (LOI) issued shall be deemed to be withdrawn.
 - i. The applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of infrastructure for teaching and training facilities as specified in "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurved Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016";
- ii. The applicant shall fulfill all the requirements of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016";

- iii. The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions of Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2003" read with amendment Regulations of 2013; and its applicant chall fulfill all the relevant provisions up doubted to 2003.
- iv. The applicant shall fulfill all the relevant provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970.
- 6. The applicant is also need to submit the requisite Performance Bank Guarantee as specified under the section 6 (1) (g) of notified Regulations namely the "Establishment of New Medical College, Opening of New or Higher Course of Study or Training and Increase of Admission Capacity by a Medical College Regulations, 2003" read with amendment Regulations of 2013".
- 7. The college administration is to ensure that no student is admitted in the above mentioned UG course till the formal permission by issue of Letter of Permission (LOP) of the Central Government is granted.
- 8. The CCIM will visit the proposed college to verify the compliance of the fulfillment of the above conditions by the applicant, and recommendations for issuing the LOP will be furnished to the Central Government.
- 9. In the event, the applicant college fails to comply with or satisfy the conditions of the Letter of Intent; the Letter of Intent shall be deemed to have been withdrawn without further intimation to the applicant.

- (iv) More instrument and work should be increased in Path-lab under Hospital. In Department of Sharirkriya Chemicals are inadequate.

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's letter No. L.14012/12/2018-EP (IM-1) dated 29.07.2019 related to admission matter for the academic year 2019-20, intimating certain requirements to be fulfilled by the college for consideration of permission for the academic session 2020-21.

2. Further, refer to the CCIM's letter No.Ref.3-3/2020-Ay. (107) dated 21.09.2020 forwarding therewith recommendation of the college to the Central Government based on thorough examination of the visitation report Part-I, indemnity bond, affidavit & latest details of teaching, non-teaching and hospital staff submitted by the college along with the assessment report, as the physical verification by conduction of inspection could not be carried out in view of present COVID-19 pandemic situation for the A.Y. 2020-21. On examining the same, it is found that, the college is not fulfilling the requirement related to Website as specified in sub-regulation (2) of regulation 9 of RMS, 2016 and therefore, an opportunity for Hearing/Compliance to update the website by 14.10.2020 was granted to the college under the provision of IMCC Act, 1970.

3. The Compliance submitted by the college and recommendations & assessment report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criterion for granting Conditional Permission for UG (BAMS) course.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to grant Conditional Permission to "Dr. Deepak Patil Ayurvedic Medical College & Research Centre, AIP Borpadale, Tal. Panhala, Distt. Kolhapur-416213, Maharashtra" for conducting 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2020-21 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to the following:

6. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under IMCC Act & Regulations made thereunder.

7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Board of Governors, CCIM and the Central Government.

8. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2020 to get permission for the session 2021-22:

- (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*

9. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to CCIM under intimation to this Ministry. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report along with its assessment in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2021-22.

Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- 1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Dr. Deepak Patil Ayurvedic Medical College and Research Center, A/p Borpadale, Tal. Panhala, Dist. Kolhapur-416213, Maharashtra (Inst. ID AYU0586) inspection of your College was conducted on 22.02.2024 & 23.02.2024 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Asessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission for 60 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
- 2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. **On careful examination of the assessment report following shortcoming/defect have been observed**
 - a) Availability of teaching staff is $\frac{Available}{Required} x100\% = \frac{29}{30} x100\% = 96.66\%$.

- 3. Further, the assessment report was placed in the **94**th **Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **25.06.2024 and the Board concluded that the college is not** fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, However, the college is fulfilling the criteria required for issuance of permission as per the Regulation 3 (3) of MSR 2016. Hence, the Board decided to issue the conditional permission for 60 seats under in UG (BAMS) course, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25.
- 4. Therefore, Conditional Permission is issued to Dr. Deepak Patil Ayurvedic Medical College and Research Center, A/p Borpadale, Tal. Panhala, Dist. Kolhapur-416213, Maharashtra (Inst. ID AYU0586) for 60 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25, subject to the condition that aforementioned shortcoming shall be fulfilled along with the following requirements: -

- Ι. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
- Π, It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity with 60 seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- III It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no. BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatary Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- 6. Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
- 7. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 8 The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31^{st} December, 2024 and compliance report should be sent to get permission for the academic session 2025-2026:
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - ii) All the requirements of minimum standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in MES (Assessment & Rating for Undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of iii) Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022.
 - iv) The shortcoming mentioned in point no 2,
- The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report 9. should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
